# A brief overview of the organization

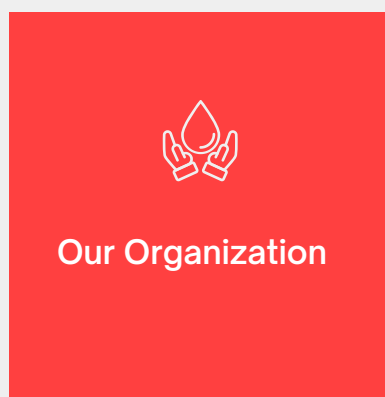

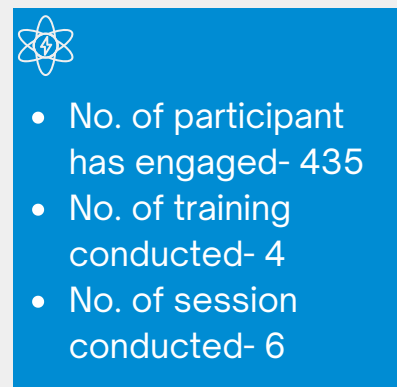
# Adolescent Awareness Programme

The Know Your Body Know Your Rights (KYBK YR) program, supported by The YP Foundation, is designed to empower adolescents and youth in Uska bazar block of Siddharthnagar district. It aims to provide them with accurate and stigma-free information on health, sexuality, and human rights, thereby enabling them to advocate for their well-being at personal, community, and block levels. The primary objective of this program is to ensure that young people are well-informed and equipped with the necessary tools to make informed decisions about their health and assert their rights.

# Family Planning Programme

The family planning program is a high priority area of focus for our organization, and we are currently covering 10 villages. As part of our efforts, we have successfully created and trained a pool of 20 Community Champions (CC) who are actively advocating for family planning issues within their communities and establish 10 helpdesk. Some of our most active CCs include Khushboo, Urmila, Mainawati, Maya Singh, and Suman, who have been working diligently to educate their communities on the importance of family planning and the available options for contraception. Through their efforts, we have been able to raise awareness and

increase access to family planning services, helping to improve the health and well-being of women and families in these villages.

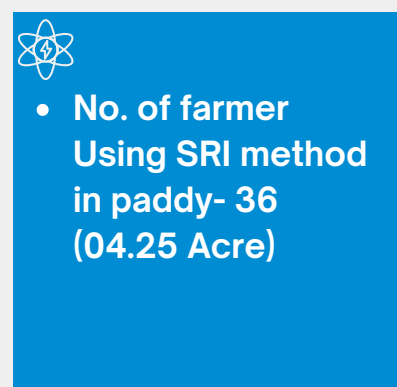
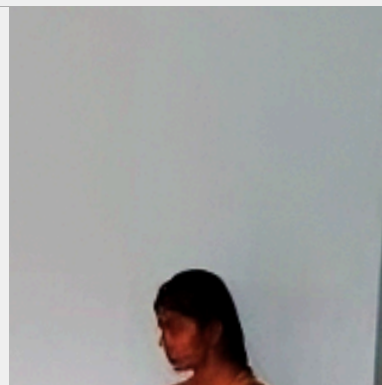
# Sustainable Agriculture Based Livelihood Programme

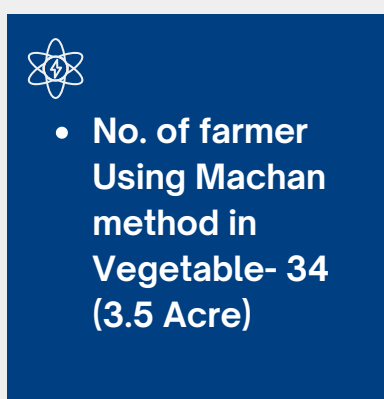

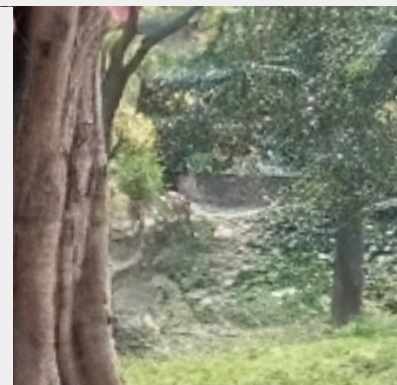
# Men's And SRHR

The SAHAYOG program by Swabhiman Samiti aims to promote gender equality, end violence against women and girls, and involve men and boys as responsible partners. It focuses on transforming institutions and goes beyond behavior change strategies. The program has worked with 240 men and boys and 120 women in 12 groups to promote gender justice, sensitize them to women's health and rights, and encourage social change. Its goal is to create a violence-free life for all by promoting gender equality and equal enjoyment of human rights. The program also aims to address the root causes of violence against women by engaging men and boys in the process of ending gender-based violence. It takes a holistic approach by addressing individual behavior, as well as institutional and systemic factors contributing to gender inequality and violence.

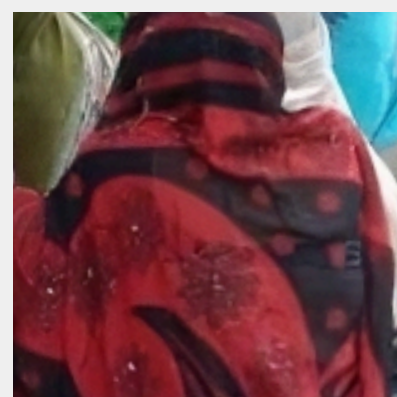

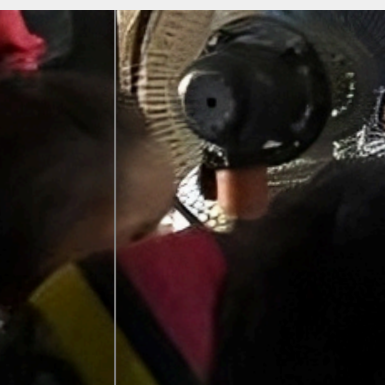
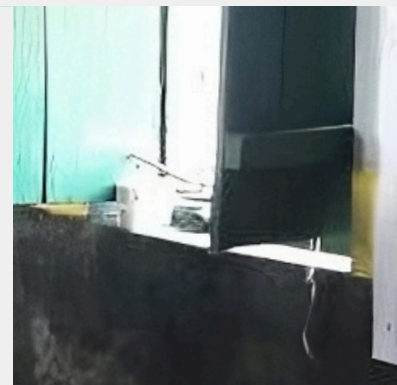
# Flood Relief Programme

The Swabhiman Samiti initiated a Flood Relief Programme in Uska Bazar, Siddharthnagar district. The program aimed to provide relief material to the poor and daily wage laborers affected by the floods. With the support of ActionAid Association, an international NGO, Swabhiman Samiti distributed food and hygiene kits to 200 families, helping them meet their basic needs. This assistance alleviated the hardships faced by the affected population, who had lost their livelihoods due to the floods. Swabhiman Samiti's efforts made a positive impact on the lives of those affected by the floods.

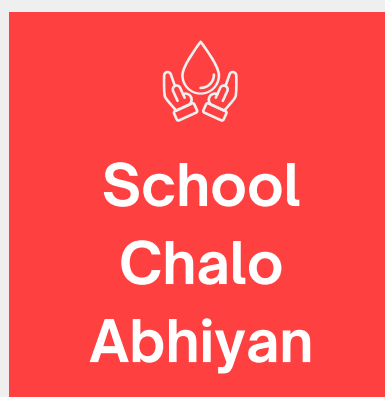
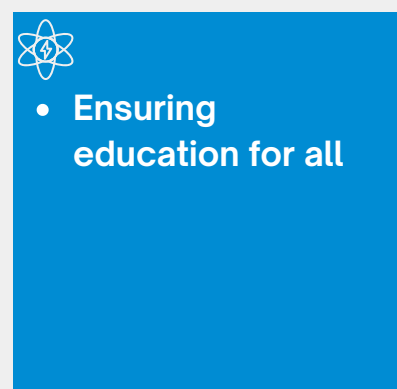
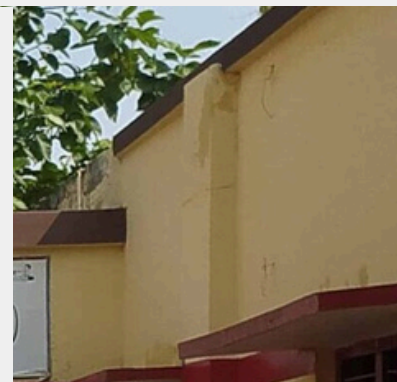
# School Chalo Abhiyan

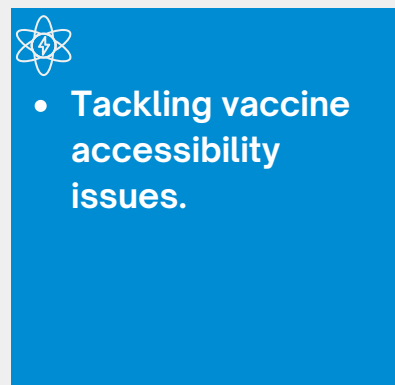
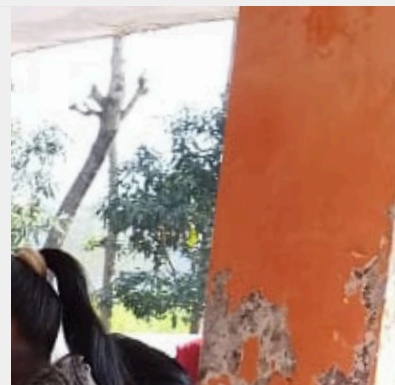
# COVID-19 Vaccination

The Covid-19 pandemic has created an unprecedented public health crisis, affecting millions of people worldwide. The virus has spread rapidly, resulting in significant loss of lives and economic disruption. The development of vaccines against Covid-19 has provided a significant opportunity to contain the spread of the virus and protect vulnerable populations. However, vaccine hesitancy and access to vaccines have remained significant barriers in achieving high vaccination coverage. To address these challenges, Sahyog Society for Participatory Rural Development and Vinod Kumar Prajapati (Secretary, Swabhiman Samiti) conducted a 100% Vaccination Campaign to ensure 100% Covid vaccination in the entire population of CHC uska bazar siddharth nagar, ensuring both doses to all the identified persons, from November 1, 2021, to April 30, 2022.

किया गया और साथ ही अन्य देशों में भी आंदोलन शुरू हो गया। संभावती ने एल, जी, बी, टी, का मतलब लैसबियन, गे, बाई सेक्सुअल, ट्रांसजेंडर के बारे में विस्तार पूर्वक से बताया। हरिनारायण के द्वारा ट्रांसजेंडर के बारे में बताया कि एक ट्रांसजेंडर व्यक्ति वह होता है, जिनका जेंडर समाज द्वारा जेंडर से भिन्न होता है। ट्रांस लोगों को चुनौतियों का सामना करना पड़ता है और अधिकारों तक पहुंच बनाने में काफी कठिनाई आती है। तो हमें ट्रांस लोगों को अपने समान प्यार सम्मान और अधिकार देना चाहिए ताकी भेदभाव और हिंसा न हो और
