Secretary's Message

Dear Members, Partners, and Friends,

It is my pleasure to share Swabhiman Samiti's Annual Report for 2024–2025, a year in which we deepened our impact through innovative programmes and strong collaboration. Each programme addressed critical community needs and aligned with our priorities in health, education, and gender equity. Our work focused on four major initiatives:

- **Project Chhalaang** introduced physical literacy and social-emotional learning across 50 rural schools in Siddharthnagar, improving students' fitness, coordination, and teamwork skills.
- **Digital Classroom Program at KGBV ITWA** partnered with eVidyaloka to equip girls with essential computer skills and spark interest in STEM, achieving over 90 percent completion and high participation rates.
- **eVidyaloka EmpowerEd** Program extended digital learning to 20 KGBV schools in Siddharthnagar and Maharajganj, providing infrastructure, volunteer instruction, and real-time progress tracking.
- **Kishori Sashaktikaran Pariyojna**, in collaboration with the Azim Premji Foundation Grameen and Vikas Sansthan, empowered 525 adolescent girls with sexual and reproductive health education, menstrual hygiene training, and life skills, leading to reduced early marriages and sustained school attendance.

These successes reflect the dedication of our field teams, volunteers, and partners. We thank our donors, government agencies, and community partners for their invaluable support.

On September 4, 2024, Swabhiman Samiti celebrated its 20th Foundation Day at the Uska Bazar office, marking two decades of dedicated service in disaster management, education, health, women's empowerment, and community development. Distinguished guests worshipped Goddess Saraswati and lit the lamp, after which staff, volunteers, beneficiaries, and dignitaries reflected on our journey—from humble beginnings to our current footprint across Siddharthnagar and Maharajganj districts—and recommitted themselves to driving positive change in the years ahead.

As we move into 2025–2026, we will build on this momentum, scaling our interventions to reach more children and communities. Together, we remain steadfast in our mission to empower the next generation—physically, emotionally, and digitally.

Swabhiman Samiti's programmes are centred in three neighbouring districts of eastern Uttar Pradesh—Siddharthnagar, Maharajganj and Kushinagar—where we work hand-in-hand with communities to tackle interlinked challenges. Tailoring each intervention to local needs and cultural contexts, we deliver sustainable solutions across eight strategic domains:



01 Siddharthnagar

Siddharthnagar is a district in the northeastern part of Uttar Pradesh, India. It shares an international border with Nepal, making it a strategically significant location. Siddharthnagar an Aspirational District in Uttar Pradesh, focuses on improving health, education, and agriculture while empowering marginalized communities and fostering sustainable development initiatives.

02 Maharajganj

Maharajganj, a district in Uttar Pradesh, shares an international border with Nepal, making it strategically and culturally significant. Predominantly rural, its economy is driven by agriculture and small-scale industries. The region faces challenges in education, healthcare, and women's empowerment

03 Kushinagar

Kushinagar is a prominent district in Uttar Pradesh, India, known for its spiritual significance as the place where Lord Buddha attained Mahaparinirvana. With a largely agrarian population, the district faces challenges in education, health, rural development, sustainable livelihoods, digital education, and community empowerment.

Our Project /Programmes

Project Chhalaang

Project Chhalaang is a joint initiative of Swabhiman Samiti and the ELMS Sports Foundation, launched in April 2024 across 50 government primary schools in the Siddharthnagar district of Uttar Pradesh. Designed to bridge gaps in physical education and social-emotional learning (SEL), the project empowers children with the skills, confidence, and resilience they need both inside and outside the classroom.

Objective

- Enhance overall physical literacy, including endurance, strength, balance, and coordination.
- Foster social-emotional competencies—self-awareness, empathy, teamwork, and emotional regulation—through structured play and reflection.
- Build teacher capacity to integrate SEL and physical activities into daily lesson plans.
- Stimulate community support for regular PE classes and active lifestyles.



Our Project /Programmes

Project Chhalaang

Key Activities

1. **Baseline Assessment:** Conducted physical fitness and SEL surveys for 3,000 students to tailor the curriculum.
2. **Teacher Training:** Delivered five 2-day workshops for 75 PE instructors on age-appropriate drills, game-based learning, and SEL facilitation.
3. **Student Sessions:** Rolled out twice-weekly 45-minute PE modules combining athletics, team sports, mindfulness exercises, and peer-learning circles.
4. **Community Engagement:** Organized monthly “Sport for All” days inviting parents and local leaders to observe and participate in children’s activities.
5. **Monitoring & Evaluation:** Used a mobile app to track attendance, skill acquisition, and SEL growth through pre- and post-program assessments.

Achievements

- Physical fitness scores rose by an average of 30 percent.
- Over 85 percent of students demonstrated improved teamwork and emotional regulation.
- Teacher confidence in delivering PE and SEL content increased by 60 percent.
- Active community participation resulted in two newly renovated playgrounds.
- 300 students trained as youth leaders

Sustainability & Next Steps

Building on these successes, Swabhimani Samiti will integrate Chhalaang’s curriculum into education plans, train an additional teachers in 2025, and secure government and corporate partnerships to expand the model to neighbouring districts.

Digital Classroom Program

The Digital Classroom Program at Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV) ITWA, Siddharthnagar, is a collaboration between Swabhiman Samiti and eVidyaloka. It aims to bridge the digital divide for rural girls by equipping them with foundational computer skills and fostering enthusiasm for STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics).

Objective

- Provide hands-on training in basic computer operations, internet navigation, and office applications.
- Cultivate interest in STEM subjects through project-based learning and interactive lessons.
- Improve learning outcomes and digital confidence among girls in grades 6–10.
- Build local capacity for sustained digital education through teacher and assistant training.



Our Project /Programmes

Digital Classroom Program

Key Activities

1. **Infrastructure Setup:** Installed computers, projectors, speakers, and reliable internet connectivity in the school's digital lab.
2. **Teacher & Assistant Training:** Conducted three intensive workshops for class assistants and teachers on digital pedagogy, e-learning platforms, and troubleshooting.
3. **Volunteer-Led Sessions:** Engaged eVidyaloka volunteer teachers to deliver twice-weekly interactive lessons on coding basics, digital research, and virtual experiments.
4. **STEM Clubs:** Established after-school clubs where students collaborated on mini science projects and presentations.
5. **Progress Tracking:** Monitored attendance, skill mastery, and engagement using an online dashboard, with fortnightly feedback loops.

Achievements

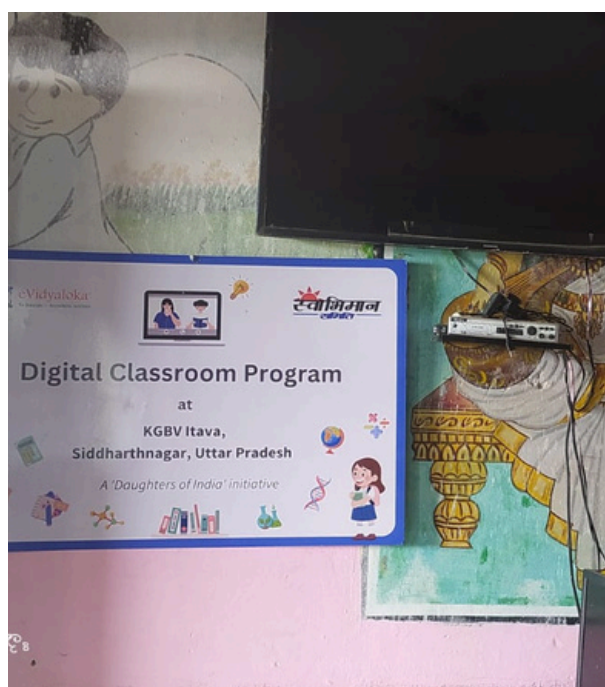
- **Completion Rate:** 92 percent of enrolled students completed the full curriculum.
- **Skill Gains:** Average post-test scores rose by 45 percent in digital literacy assessments.
- **STEM Engagement:** Over 60 percent of participants joined STEM clubs and presented projects to peers.
- **Recognition:** Two top performers awarded scholarships for district-level STEM fairs.

eVidyaloka EmpowerEd: Digital Literacy Program

Launched in June 2024 in collaboration with eVidyaloka and implemented by Swabhimani Samiti, the EmpowerEd program brings high-quality digital learning to 20 Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV) schools across Siddharthnagar and Maharajganj districts. By installing digital classrooms and pairing them with volunteer-driven online instruction, EmpowerEd aims to bridge the rural digital divide and foster academic growth.

Objective

- Equip girls with foundational digital skills (computer operation, internet use, basic productivity software).
- Enhance interest and confidence in STEM subjects through interactive, project-based learning.
- Build local capacity by training class assistants and teachers in e-pedagogy and classroom maintenance.
- Establish a scalable model for digital education that can be replicated in neighbouring districts.



Our Project /Programmes

eVidyaloka EmpowerEd: Digital Literacy Program

Key Activities

1. **Digital Lab Setup:** Installed computers, projectors, webcams, speakers, and secured broadband connectivity in each of the 20 KGBV schools.
2. **Capacity Building:** Conducted four two-day workshops for 60 class assistants and teachers on digital teaching tools, lesson planning, and basic hardware troubleshooting.
3. **Volunteer Engagement:** Recruited and oriented 30 eVidyaloka volunteer teachers to deliver twice-weekly live lessons in English, maths, science, and digital skills.
4. **STEM Project Clubs:** Facilitated after-school STEM clubs where students collaborated on coding challenges, virtual science experiments, and multimedia presentations.
5. **Monitoring & Feedback:** Utilized an online dashboard to track student attendance, assignment completion, and skill mastery; held monthly review meetings with school leadership.

Achievements

- **Full Infrastructure Roll-out:** All 20 schools operational with fully equipped digital labs within two months.
- **High Participation:** 94 % average attendance in digital sessions, with 88 % of students completing the full curriculum.
- **Skill Improvement:** Post-program assessments showed a 50 % average increase in digital literacy scores.
- **Teacher Readiness:** 85 % of trained assistants and teachers reported confidence in continuing digital lessons independently.
- **Positive Stakeholder Feedback:** School principals and parents reported marked improvements in students' engagement and classroom performance.

Kishori Sashaktikaran Pariyojna

Implemented in 2024 by Swabhiman Samiti in partnership with the Azim Premji Foundation Grameen and Vikas Sansthan, the Kishori Sashaktikaran Pariyojna empowers adolescent girls in the Uska Bazar block of Siddharthnagar district. Focusing on sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR), menstrual hygiene, early-marriage prevention, and life skills, the project leverages community engagement, peer education, and capacity building.

- Equip 525 adolescent girls with comprehensive SRHR knowledge and safe menstrual-hygiene practices.
- Prevent early marriage through awareness campaigns and community dialogue.
- Improve school retention and encourage continued education.
- Develop leadership and life-skills via youth clubs and peer-mentoring.

Kishori Sashaktikaran Pariyojna

Key Activities

1. **Baseline Survey:** Assessed SRHR awareness, menstrual hygiene practices, and school-attendance patterns among 525 girls.
2. **Peer-Educator Training:** Trained 30 adolescent girls as peer educators to deliver interactive SRHR sessions and model hygienic behaviours.
3. **Community Workshops:** Held monthly village-level workshops with parents, teachers, and local leaders on the harms of early marriage and the importance of girls' education.
4. **Life-Skills Camps:** Organized four two-day camps covering decision-making, communication, self-esteem, and goal-setting.
5. **Kishori Groups:** Established 20 "Kishori Clubs" to sustain peer support, discussion forums, and mentorship activities.
6. **Exposure Visits:** Organized visits to health centres and vocational training institutes, broadening girls' horizons and aspirations.
7. **Kishori Mela:** District-level fest showcasing girls' projects and performances, inaugurated by school principals and district officers to celebrate achievements and galvanize wider community support.

Achievements

1. **SRHR Knowledge:** 90 % of participants demonstrated accurate understanding of reproductive health and rights in post-tests.
2. **Menstrual Hygiene:** 85 % adopted safe practices—use of sanitary materials and proper disposal methods.
3. **Early Marriage Reduction:** Reported a 40 % decrease in early-marriage intentions within participating villages.
4. **Attendance Gains:** School retention among participants improved by 25 %.
5. **Youth Leadership:** 20 peer educators actively mentor over 525 younger girls.

Climate Change & Disaster Risk Reduction Program

On June 15, 2024, Swabhiman Samiti convened its annual Climate Change & Disaster Risk Reduction (CC & DRR) Program at Uska Bazar, focusing on advanced early-warning systems, safety, and climate-smart adaptation measures to further bolster community resilience.

Focus Areas:

- Pilot flood alerts and village siren network
- Refresher workshops on VDMP review with updated climate data
- Formation of School Disaster Management Teams and realistic mock drills
- Hands-on rooftop rainwater harvesting installations
- Demonstrations of climate-resilient cropping and soil conservation techniques

Key Outcomes:

- 10 VDMPs updated with real-time early-warning protocols
- SMS alert system operational in 4 pilot villages
- 12 rainwater harvesting units installed in schools and community centres
- 25 teachers & youth trained as School Safety Coordinators
- 1,200 saplings planted with 88% six-month survival rate

Agriculture-Based Livelihood Program

The Agriculture-Based Livelihood Program, implemented by Swabhiman Samiti in collaboration with the District Agriculture Office and Krishi Vigyan Kendra, aimed to strengthen farm resilience and income for smallholders in the Uska Bazar block of Siddharthnagar District, Uttar Pradesh. Running in 2024 – 25, the project prioritized climate-smart practices, water-management technologies, organic input production, value addition, and digital market linkages.

Focus Areas:

- Precision sowing, soil-moisture monitoring, and drought-tolerant crop selection.
- Hands-on support for installing drip and sprinkler irrigation systems.
- Vermicompost pit construction and bio-pesticide formulation workshops.

Key Outcomes:

- 38% of trainees installed systems, reducing water use by 30%.
- 46% set up vermicompost pits, cutting synthetic input costs by 40%.
- 60 Kisan Credit Cards issued; 55 farmers insured under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima.

Sports Material Distribution in 50 Pre-Secondary Schools

In collaboration with the ELMS Sports Foundation, Swabhimani Samiti distributed essential sports equipment to 50 pre-secondary schools across Siddharthnagar district. The drive reached 32 schools in the Uska Bazar block and 18 schools in the Lotan block—including Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya, Uska Bazar—to strengthen physical-education infrastructure and boost student engagement in sports.

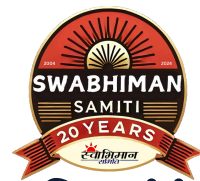

Digital Classroom Setup Initiative by Swabhiman Samiti

On 29th July 2024, Swabhiman Samiti launched a transformative initiative to set up digital classrooms in 20 Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas across Siddharthnagar and Maharajganj districts. Inaugurated by Shri Devendra Kumar Pandey, District Basic Education Officer of Siddharthnagar—who ceremonially handed over a laptop to the warden of Birdpur KGBV—the project provided laptops, smart TVs, web cameras, 4G LTE routers, speakers, inverters with batteries, and battery trolleys to ensure uninterrupted digital learning.
